7) Discussion and possible action on the following proposed amendments to the Employee Personnel policies of Section 16.2 concerning Vacation Leave:

1. *After one year of continuous service (1) one week (49 hrs. for Law Enforcement employees and 40 hrs. for all other employees) of paid vacation leave is authorized.*

2. *Between 3-5 years of continuous service (2) two weeks (86 hrs. for Law Enforcement employees and 80 hrs. for all other employees) of paid vacation leave is authorized.*

**Scott motioned to approve, Linda seconded. Tom yes, Jim yes, Don yes, Linda yes, Scott yes.**

3. *At 6 years of continuous service and thereafter (3) three weeks (135 hrs. for Law Enforcement employees and 120 hrs. for all other employees) of paid vacation leave per year is authorized.*

8) Discussion and possible action on hiring a part-time Reserve Officer, at \$18.00 per hour, working at least 6-8 hours per week.

Keith spoke, advising he is still down 1 full-time officer. That his part-time officer has been busy with personal pressing matters, so he has not been working much. Keith said he will expect this part-time officer to work no more than 20 hours per week and that the hours will be at his discretion, when needed. He said he is looking at 1 of 3 guys for this position.

9) Discussion and possible action on implementing a processing and release impound fee of \$25.00 payable to the West Siloam Springs Police Department for vehicles towed under their authority.

Keith said this was brought to his attention when he attended the recent Police Chiefs' conference/training, and that other small towns have implemented similar practices, but are typically charging more than this proposed amount.

He advised this is needed, as the wrecker doing the towing does not have access to some of the credentials, paperwork that we do, and that this is something we need to implement.
